Information for Lodge 359 Welders who wish to work in Alberta

All welding work through Local 146 in Alberta requires journeyman welders to possess a *valid Alberta pressure welding ticket*.

Renewal of Alberta Pressure Ticket (f3f4)

- If welder has an Alberta Pressure ticket with a "W" file number, ie:
 W-21000 and wishes to renew that ticket, they can do so at the Local 146
 Learning Center in Edmonton or Calgary, free of charge.
- Tig tickets can be renewed also (carbon and SS).
- Learning Center hours are: Monday Friday, 8:00 a.m. 4:30 p.m.
- Tests should be arranged in mornings if possible.
- Practice time is also free to all Lodge 359 members.

To do an initial B Pressure Ticket in Alberta

Welders who do not have an Alberta B Pressure Ticket can obtain one with the following:

- If welder has both a Red Seal as a welder and an up to date BC P-100, they qualify to simply pay a \$130.00 fee to the Alberta Boiler's Safety Association (ABSA) who will give them a reciprocal Alberta B Pressure Certificate.
- If welder has Red Seal but does not possess an up to date P-100, they will need to apply to ABSA to do the B Pressure test at any ABSA test center in Alberta. This test cannot be done at Local 146 and must be booked with ABSA. These bookings usually need to be made 2 3 weeks in advance. Test fee is \$130.00. Test in 2G-5G position positions on a 6" pipe, 6010 root, 7018 fill and cap.

Welders who do not have the Red Seal

Only if Alberta contractors are willing to do "Provisional C Tickets" can welders who do not have a Red Seal obtain work through Local 146. These welders will need three years' documented pressure welding experience and a valid pressure ticket from B.C. (F3F4, SMAW – as written in BC Log Book).
